

2010 Scholarship for Master's and Doctoral Degree Programs at Beihang University Sponsored by the Chinese Government

The Scholarship

The Chinese Government Scholarships support overseas students who wish to pursue their Master's Degree or Doctoral Degree to study at Beihang University.

The scholarship covers tuition fees, living allowance, normal medical service, comprehensive medical insurance, as well as text books fees.

Eligibility

For master programs candidates should have a bachelor's degree and be under the age of 35 and for Doctoral programs candidates should hold a master's degree and be under the age of 40.

Documents Required

- Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship (download from International School website: <http://is.buaa.edu.cn>);
- Highest diploma (notarized photocopy);
- Notarized transcripts of last formal schooling;
- A study or research plan (no less than 500 words);
- Two letters of recommendation by professors or experts;

All documents required should be in Chinese or English or provided with translations in Chinese or English.

- Please visit the website of Beihang International School (<http://is.buaa.edu.cn>) for program and course information;
- Instruction language will be English or Chinese. Applicants are required to choose instruction language in Item 4 of the Application Form. A one-year Chinese training program will be arranged for students who are not able to take courses in English and wish to take their courses in Chinese;



- Applicants are required to send application documents to International Division, Beihang University before **January 15, 2010**.
- Results of admission will be publicized before January 30 and Admission Notice will be mailed to the successful applicants.

A Brief Introduction to Beihang University

Beihang University (BUAA), formerly known as Beijing University of Aeronautics and Astronautics, was founded in 1952. It was the first university of aeronautical and astronautical engineering in China. Not long after it was founded, Beihang was recognised as one of China's sixteen key universities and since then the government of China has made support of Beihang University a priority. Today Beihang has developed into a research university with a strong focus on aeronautics and astronautics. At present, Beihang has over 23,000 students, 13,000 of whom are undergraduates and 10,000 postgraduates. The university offers a total of 49 doctoral programs, 144 master programs and 48 bachelor programs.

In 2008 BUAA accepted more than 800 foreign students from more than 40 countries. Of these more than 400 are currently studying for degree programs, including master or doctoral degrees while more than 400 others are studying the Chinese language at the Beihang Chinese Training Center. All courses at Beihang University at post graduate level can be given in English.

Beihang University - one of the most famous universities in China – is equipped with advanced laboratories and teaching facilities. The university campus is located close to Beijing's High-Tech Park and it is noted for its attractive environment, convenience of transportation and comprehensive services to support the needs of students, such as first-rate sports facilities, banks, a post office, a canteen and so on.
